There is a \$3 cost for in-person sessions. The cost of the 2021 Dubois County YQCA in-person trainings will be covered by the 4-H Council. All in-person trainings will be held in the Clover Pavilion at Dubois County 4-H Fairgrounds.

To exhibit beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, goats, poultry, and rabbits, 4-H members MUST BE certified through the YQCA program.

There are 2 ways to be YQCA certified:

1. Youth attend an in-person YQCA training.

Registration for an in-person training is required. Register through Events on version 2 4-H Online. v2.4honline.com

2. Youth may complete the entire course online at yqca.learngrow.io
Pay a \$12 fee for online certification.

Test Out option available now. Must meet the following criteria:

- *Only available to youth in the FIRST year of intermediate (age 12), senior (age 15), and young adult (age 19)*
- *Test consists of 50 questions and requires a pass rate of 80% or better.*
- *Users will have ONE chance to take the test-out option for each level.*
