

## **4-H POULTRY POSTER/SCIENCE DISPLAY**

This project is open to any enrolled 4-H member. Exhibiting live poultry is not a required part of this project. The purpose is to visually demonstrate knowledge of poultry. Develop an idea and build it into an attractive display as well as learn the technical aspect of some part of the poultry industry. Any 4-H poultry project member may exhibit a poster.

Each exhibit must be clearly labeled in the lower right hand corner with the 4-H'ers name. Appropriate labels should be obtained from the Extension Office. Posters are to be 22"x28" and displayed horizontally with stiff backing and plastic protective covering. A 3-dimensional exhibit is preferred for poultry science displays. Poultry science displays must occupy a space no larger than 30" deep x 48" wide x 72" high.

All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.
