Dear 4-H Bucket Calf Member,

Just a reminder, you are enrolled in the Bucket Calf project and if you wish to show at the 2021 Hamilton County 4-H Fair your calf must be enrolled by **May 15, 2021**. To enroll the animal, you must complete the **Beef Feeder Calves ID** enrollment at v2.4honline.com (even if your bucket calf is a dairy calf). You also need to stop by the Extension Office and pick up an ear tag number for that animal before May 15.

DEADLINE UPDATE: In 2021 May 15 falls on a Saturday. In 2021 Livestock entries will be accepted on the following business day, Monday, May 17, 2021.

Note: The Board of Animal Health (BOAH) is not requiring participants to have animal health forms for the County and State Fair. Animals will be physically inspected prior to entering the barn and may be rejected or removed due to health issues at anytime during the fair.


Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA): 4-H'ers planning to exhibit beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, poultry and rabbits **MUST BE CERTIFIED** through YQCA.
