DEADLINE UPDATE: In 2021 May 15 falls on a Saturday. In 2021 Livestock entries will be accepted on the following business day, Monday, May 17, 2021.

Remember, you may show a maximum of 12 entries plus one meat pen. You may not show more than three (3) breeds of rabbits. A meat pen is not considered a breed class. The rabbits you plan to show at the Hamilton County 4-H Fair **MUST** be enrolled on this form.


All rabbits to be sold in the 4-H Livestock Auction must be shown in a meat class. ALL sale animals are slaughtered immediately following the auction.


