I hope you are as excited about the Pulaski County 4-H & Community Fair as we are at the Extension Office! We look forward to a more 'normal' fair and summer season.



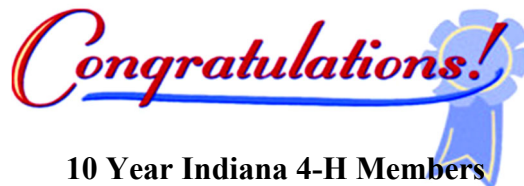

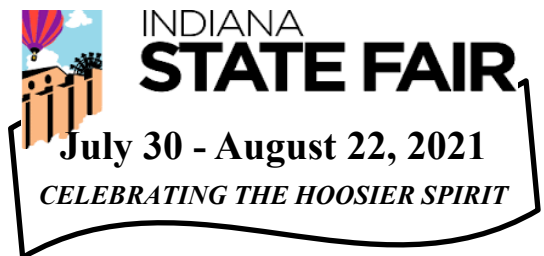


Quick reminders that can help 4-Hers to be better prepared for the fair:

- Books with completed activities and record sheets should be handed in with your project.
- Foam poster board and plastic sleeves are available in the Extension Office. Cost: \$4.00 per poster board and sleeve set.
- Carefully read project rules and descriptions to check that you have completed the project correctly.
- All FOODS exhibits must include the recipe on a State Fair Recipe Card available at the Extension Office or online. Cover the card with a zip-lock bag or clear plastic. Be prepared to take a picture!
- All CRAFT projects will need a 4-H Craft Information Card. If you are not sure if your project requires one, contact the office.
- All 4-H projects need to be picked up on **Thursday, July 1st from 4-6 PM**



If you plan to exhibit livestock at the Pulaski County 4-H & Community Fair, you must complete a YQCA training by June 1st! You can complete the training by going to yqca.learn-grow.io and logging in with your 4honline credentials. The online training costs \$12.



2021 State Fair Check-in

During the release of projects, July 1st from 4-6 pm, all 4-H'ers who were awarded State Fair entries will receive a letter with dates and instructions on when your projects need to go to the State Fair.

Projects (except foods) need to be brought into the Extension Office no later than Thursday, July 28. Families taking their own projects to the State Fair may do so on July 31st from 8am-5pm.

Food projects need to be into the Extension Office between 7-8 am on August 4th or before. Please make sure all food projects have the 5x7 State Fair Recipe Card covered in plastic.

All projects need to be packaged for safe travels. Anything larger than 24 inches in length and width need to be transported by the owner. The Extension office is not responsible for assembling any projects in any way or form.

Project References

All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.
