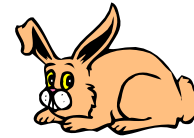

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) Training



All 4-H members exhibiting Beef, Dairy, Sheep, Goats, Swine, Poultry and Rabbits are required to complete a YQCA certification training online at yqca.org before July 15th.

Register for a YQCA class at: www.yqca.org and choose the “4honline option” to enter using your 4honline e-mail and password. Select the online training option and the cost of the online course is \$12.00.
