EXTENSION OFFICE CONTACTS

The Extension Office will be located directly across from the Junior Leaders' pop stand, between the Coliseum and East Wing of the building. You can see the map to know where we will be located.

Hours of operation will be 8:00AM – 6:00PM from July 17 – 24.

FAIR ENTRY

ALL projects are due into the Fair Entry system by **July 6, 2021**. See Fair Entry instructions for more information.

PLEASE NOTE: that the Extension Office WILL BE CLOSED on July 5, 2021 and will resume normal service on July 6, 2021. For guidance regarding Fair Entry, please contact the Extension Office during business hours.

JUDGING Format and Schedule

Closed Judging- Most project judging will be “closed” judging which means members/families will come to the fairgrounds to drop off projects. They will not stay for judging. There are a few exceptions to this including Consumer Clothing, Fashion Revue, and Consumer Meats. Events will also be open including mini tractor pull, tractor operator contest, bicycle rodeo, and livestock shows.

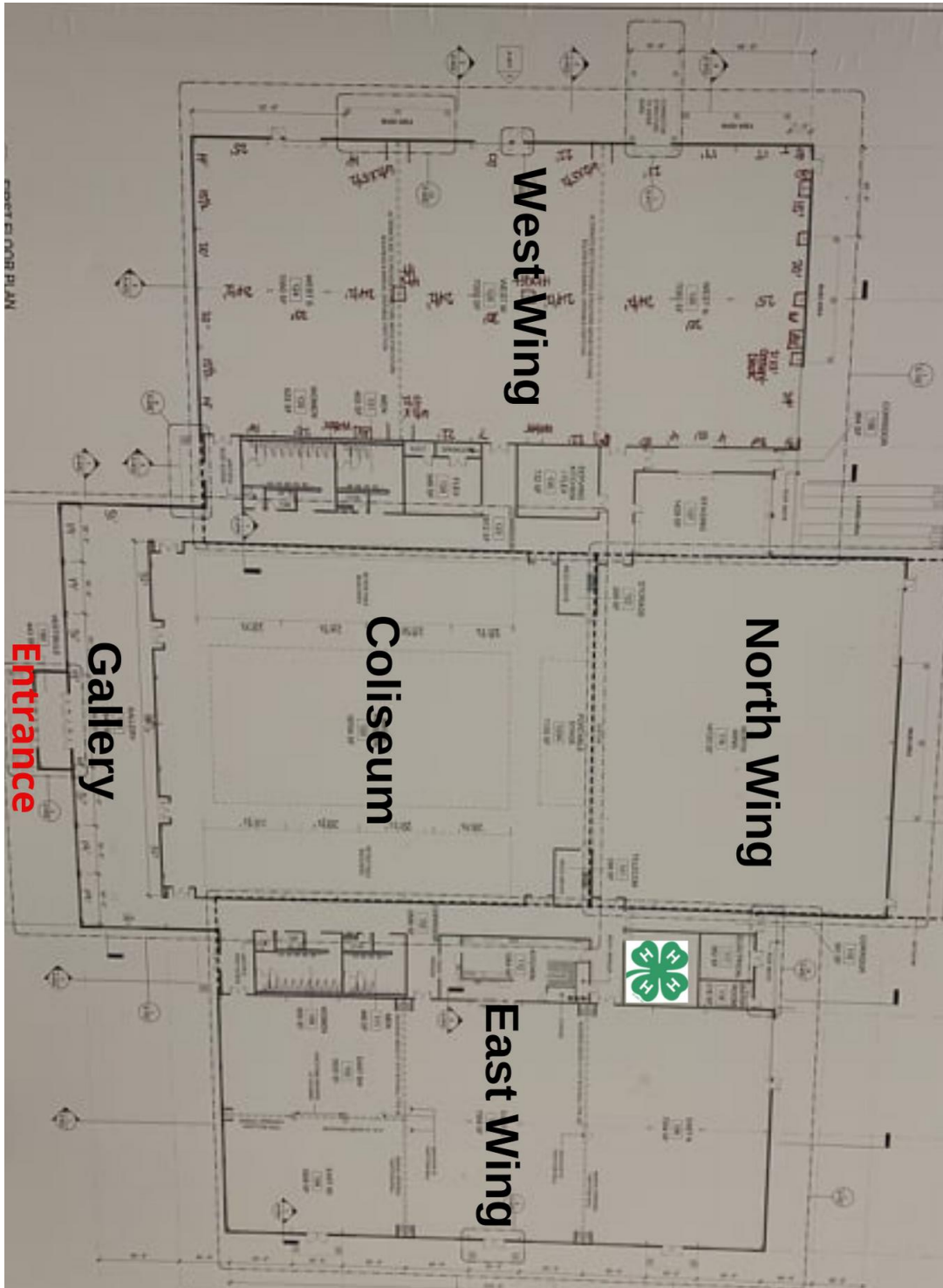
Virtual Judging- there are a few projects that are virtual only due to certain circumstances. These projects include aquatic science, communication, pocket pets, and reptiles/vivariums. The only option for judging for these 4 projects is to submit a virtual entry when you sign up in Fair entry. All other projects should include a virtual options for any members who are uncomfortable showing in-person or are unavailable during fair week. Please see the separate fair entry virtual exhibit guide to find out what is required for virtual projects. All virtual projects must be submitted by July 6th through Fair entry for judging consideration. Virtual projects will be displayed on TVs throughout the buildings during the fair.

Scoresheets and Ribbons- All scoresheets and ribbons will be distributed at project check-out on Saturday, July 25th. Members and families will need to collect these items as well as state fair letter during project check-out. Results will be posted via a public results link as well as on projects in the buildings.

RECORD SHEETS, ACHIEVEMENT SHEETS, and MANUALS

We will be collecting these items differently than we have in years past.

Project Record Sheets- These record sheets that are specific to each project. They are different than the material needed for judging like skills sheets, sewing cards, or craft cards. We ask that these project record sheets be dropped off at judging, and we will sort them together for each project.

Superintendents will have them available to view as needed. For virtual projects, members may email tippe4h@gmail.com with records. Please leave off sensitive contact information if submitting online.

White cards can be obtained on the Purdue Extension Tippecanoe county website or at our office.

Record of Achievement (aka White Cards)- These record sheets include a listing of all projects and activities that the 4-H member participated in throughout the year. These sheets will be collected in the Extension Office at the Fairgrounds in a bin that will be divided by club. Members/Families can turn these in throughout fair week. For virtual projects, members may email tippe4h@gmail.com with records. Please leave off sensitive contact information if submitting online. White cards can be obtained on the Purdue Extension Tippecanoe county website or at our office.

Manuals- If a project requires a manual to be turned in, leaders will be checking manuals at judging drop off. We do not plan to keep any manuals.
