In addition, all cats must have been tested for feline leukemia within 180 days of exhibition or have had vaccination within one (1) year of show. Cats exhibiting any symptoms of sickness determined by the project or building superintendent(s), exhibit or extension personnel, or judges will not be eligible for exhibition. Vaccination forms will be returned to you at the show. | <b>All cat County Animal Entries (FairEntry) AND Completed Record Sheets are due on or before July 1. Cat vaccination forms must be brought the day of the cat show with the 4-H member exhibiting the animal.</b> A Certificate of Vaccination (4-H 777) , dated at least 14 days prior to, but not more than one (1) year of the date of exhibition that shows cats have been vaccinated for rabies, feline panleukopenia, feline rhinotracheitis, and calicivirus. In addition, all cats must have been tested for feline leukemia within 180 days of exhibition or have had vaccination within one (1) year of show. Cats exhibiting any symptoms of sickness determined by the project or building superintendent(s), exhibit or extension personnel, or judges will not be eligible for exhibition.
