Mission Statement

The overall mission of Community & Family Services (CFS), a not-for-profit community action agency, is to lead low-income families and individuals toward independence and self-sufficiency. The (CFS) Huntington House Homeless Shelter not only provides a refuge for those who need it but also involves its residents with an array of services aimed to address barriers and the causes of homelessness. Assisted by shelter staff, Huntington House residents develop goals that will aid them toward long-term success.

Purpose

To provide short-term, immediate housing for homeless families, women and women with children who are in need. In addition to housing and meals, weekly case management is provided to assist and guide homelessness in order to become independent and self-sufficient citizens.

Requirements to become a Resident

A background check is done

No sexual or violent crimes

No felonies (exception of child support)

No current DV (we do not put our residents in danger, lack of security)

Must take a drug screen

Must be able to job search 4hrs per day (10am to 2pm)

Must be willing to do volunteer work 4hrs per week

Must be able to climb stairs and do household chores

Must be homeless

Males must be living with family unit
