WHAT: Fashion Revue, Consumer Clothing and Sewing Judging

WHEN: Monday, July 14

WHERE: Royal Off the Square (Behind People's Bank in Brownstown) ****Note Change**

Brownstown, IN 47220

DIRECTIONS: Entering Brownstown via US 50 West, turn right at the first stop light (near the County Courthouse). This is Walnut Street. They are located on the right. Just look for the blue awning. Parking is available across the street.

TIME: Doors open at 1:00 p.m.

SEWING – Wearable & Non-Wearable

GRADE 3 - Report at 1:00 p.m.

- Fashion Revue judging & non-wearable construction judging 1:15 p.m.
- Wearable construction judging immediately following Fashion Revue.

GRADE 4 - Report at 1:30 p.m.

- Fashion Revue judging & non-wearable construction judging 1:45 p.m.
- Wearable construction judging immediately following Fashion Revue.

GRADE 5 - Report at 2:00 p.m.

- Fashion Revue judging & non-wearable construction judging 2:15 p.m.
- Wearable construction judging immediately following Fashion Revue.

GRADE 6 - Report at 2:15 p.m.

- Fashion Revue judging & non-wearable construction judging 2:30 p.m.
- Wearable construction judging immediately following Fashion Revue.

GRADE 7 - Report at 2:30 p.m.

- Fashion Revue judging & non-wearable construction judging 2:45 p.m.
- Wearable construction judging immediately following Fashion Revue.

Grades 8-12 – Report at 4:00 p.m.

- Fashion Revue judging & non-wearable construction judging 4:15 p.m.
- Wearable construction judging immediately following Fashion Revue.
- **Reminder** - Upper grades (8-12) sewing members may exhibit in 2 wearable categories.

CONSUMER CLOTHING

- Grades 3 - 5 report at 2:45 p.m., judged at 3:00 p.m.
- Grades 6 - 8 report at 3:15 p.m., judged at 3:30 p.m.
- Grades 9 – 12 report at 3:30 p.m. judged at 3:45 p.m.

Consumer Clothing book and garment to exhibit will be judged by a judge after the entire outfit is modeled. Consumer Clothing members are to be prepared to answer judges' questions on construction, care, fabric content, versatility, etc. of garments.

All exhibits (wearable & non-wearable) will be judged on this day. All wearable & non-wearable

exhibits must be present on the designated date to be judged. Bring your pattern and instruction sheet to help aid judges if questions arise.

Check-In

- Upon arriving, each 4-H member will need to check-in. At the check-in table a description of your project will be recorded. You will also receive numbers for fashion revue for wearable projects.
- **PLEASE NOTE!** Senior division sewing members once you state what category you are entering your garment at the front door, you **CANNOT CHANGE**. It is important that all 4-H members report on schedule. Advanced Sewing Fashion Revue categories are: Suit/Coat, Dress up Wear, Formal, Informal or Casual Wear, Free Choice, and Separates. (Grades 8 & Up - see category descriptions listed in your 4-H Requirement Book)
- If you are unable to be present at the designated time, please make arrangements with Jeanie Schneider, (522-5892) or the Extension Office (358-6101). Any wearable sewing member who has a prearranged commitment and notifies the Youth Educator or Clothing Chairman **ONE WEEK** prior to the private dress revue can still be eligible for a construction award. (Example: required camp or school exchange trip. Family vacations and work are not excused.)
- **Enclosed is a 4-H Fashion Revue Sewing Narration Form that must be completed for all Fashion Revue participants. Please fill it out completely describing your garment and accessories. Bring this completed description sheet to the judging with you.** It will be used for narration during the public show. (If you have more than one garment, let us know and we will send you another sheet.)

Sewing Judging

- All divisions – grades 3-12 sewing members may have a wearable and/or a non-wearable exhibit.
- Sewing Project Exhibit Card - Enclosed you will find a sewing project exhibit card. Please complete and attach this card to your exhibit for sewing judging.
- Members will leave their garments at the judging and they will be taken to the Fair.

Consumer Clothing Judging

- For girls who are participating in Consumer Clothing, be sure you wear your outfit to the judging as well as bring your notebook which has been prepared according to manual instructions. Wear another change of clothes with you to the judging because your Consumer Clothing outfit will be left at the judging and will be displayed during Fair week. Consumer Clothing notebooks only (not outfits) will be selected in each grade group to send to the State Fair.

Public Fashion Revue – Sewing & Consumer Clothing

- Sewing and Consumer Clothing members who participate in Fashion Revue Judging need to attend the Public Fashion Revue on Tuesday, July 22, at 10:00 a.m. in the Grandstands at the Jackson Co. Fairgrounds.
- Any participant who is unable to come to the Public Fashion Revue must notify Jeanie Schneider, (522-5892) or the Extension Office (358-6101) BEFORE July 14. Acceptable excuses include required camp, school exchange trip etc. Family vacations and work are not excused.)
- Winners in the Fashion Revue will be announced at the Public Fashion Revue.

- All participants must pick up their wearable garments at the 4-H Exhibit Hall between 8:30 a.m. – 9: 00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 22. BE PROMPT
- All participants MUST meet in the back of the grandstand, dressed, NO LATER than 9:30 a.m. for detailed instructions.
- All participants will walk through the grandstand in their respective categories.
- The trailer will be used for changing ONLY. Otherwise, everyone should be in the grandstand.
- To be eligible for any wearable award, you must attend the Public Fashion Revue.
- All participants MUST have participated in the Private Fashion Revue in order to be eligible to model in the Public Fashion Revue unless the Extension Office and Clothing Chairman are notified.
- Please remain dressed until awards are presented.
- Once the Fashion Revue is completed, take modeled garment BACK TO THE 4-H BUILDING and return it to the same location where you picked it up. **Make sure to re-attach your name card, skill card, and ribbons!!!**
