Two scholarships are offered for i-LEaD attendees who participate in the i-LEaD program offered during Home and Family Conference at Purdue University. The scholarships will cover the registration cost of both i-LEaD and Home and Family Conference registrations. These scholarships are offered to members of the Tippecanoe County Extension Homemakers.

Guidelines for applying for scholarship

- Applicant will attend the entire conference.
- Applications must be received at the Extension Office by February 26.
- Entries will be judged by County Education Committee. The winner's name will be forwarded to the District for consideration. See attachment.
- Winners will be notified in time to register for the Home and Family Conference.

In the event the Tippecanoe County i-LEaD Award winner is selected as District winner, the first runner-up will be awarded the TCEH i-LEaD Award. If we have no applicants, or only one (1) applicant for the award who then wins the District Award, the money will remain in the treasury.

The i-LEaD winner may submit the Home & Family Conference Registration Form to the County Treasurer for payment to Purdue, or submit the form directly to Purdue with a check; then turn the Confirmation Form over to the County Treasurer for reimbursement of the registration fee only.
