About the Club: Personal sewing machine NOT required. Classes are once a month and limited to 4 or 5 students per class. Enrollment interest will determine who meets when. Pre-registration required. The club does not meet during December or on holidays. Meetings in May, June, and July may be changed, added to, or deleted.

Each class makes a different 4-H project(s), while learning pinning, cutting, sewing techniques, sewing terminology, and learning to use a computerized sewing machine. In January, students may select an individual project – one that can be entered into the Elkhart County 4-H Fair. 3rd and 4th graders might be able to finish their projects during class time. All other grades are expected to complete some work on their own in order to complete their projects in time for the fair.

Cost: Club dues are \$25 for the club year (September through July) payable by the first class meeting. This fee is in addition to the \$15 state fee paid for when enrolling in the 4-H program.
