



Triangle Scarf

What You Need

- fabric 16 inches by 16 inches
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of ribbon, $\frac{7}{8}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch wide matching thread

How to Make a Triangle Scarf

- Cut the ribbon in half.
- Place the fabric right side up. Pin one end of each piece of ribbon on opposite corners. See Figure 17a.
- Fold on the diagonal with the right sides together. Keep the ribbons tucked inside. Pin the cut edges together. See Figure 17b.
- Sew a $\frac{3}{8}$ -inch seam around the scarf, leaving a 4-inch opening along one side. Stitch across the tie ends and then backstitch to secure the ties. See Figure 17c.
- Turn scarf right side out and press.
- With hand stitching, close the opening. See Figure 17d.
- Press your triangle scarf.
