CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS
<p>Master Gardener interns (those who have successfully completed the MG Training Class) become certified Master Gardeners upon completion of 35 hours of volunteer work.</p> <p>Master Gardeners must recertify every year by completing 12 hours of volunteer work and receiving 6 hours training to maintain active Purdue Master Gardener status.</p> <p>Advanced Master Gardener certification requires at least 10 hours of additional training as well as a minimum of an additional 25 hours of service. Other levels of Advanced MG status include Bronze, Silver, and Gold. See MG Handbook or HCMGA Directory for details.</p> <p>Master Gardener and Advanced Master Gardener Badges will be distributed after hourly requirements are satisfied, submitted, and approved by the County ANR Educator. Please allow up to 4 weeks for your badge. Certificates along with Bronze, Silver, and Gold badges for HCMG will be awarded at the annual summer picnic and Christmas Dinner.</p>
