The 4-H pledge was worded by Otis Hall, Kansas State 4-H Leader.

It was approved at the first National 4-H Club Camp in 1927 in Washington, D.C. The words "my world" were added to the pledge in 1973. Their addition is the only change ever made to the 4-H pledge.
