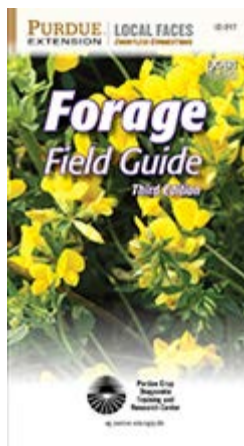

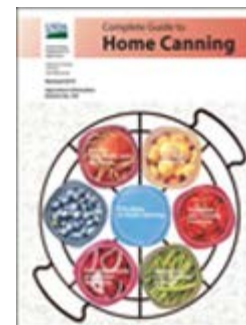

Indiana Small Farm Conference



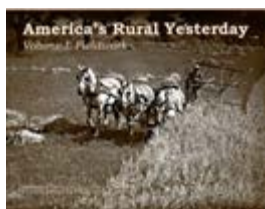
PURDUE March 3-5, 2016
