The purpose of this fund is to enable 4-H clubs and 4-H members to participate in activities that they may not be able to afford without additional monetary support. The fund is limited, so the members of the Youth Council will grant money from this fund as they see fit. To help them make their decisions you will need to fill out the following application. Only fill out one application per club event or per member. Some examples of possible activities might include field trips, club completion activities, money for club members to attend 4-H camp if they can't afford the full fee, or activities that will benefit the 4-H program or 4-H member.

Some general rules are as follows:

1. Usually a \$100 limit. (This may be negotiable.)
2. Applications will be reviewed as they are received. Please give the Youth Council as much lead time as you can.
