

# Miscellaneous Craft Project Requirements

## Arts and Crafts State Fair Project

Up to 12 Arts and Crafts exhibits from the Marion County Fair can be advanced to the State Fair as follows: Up to two exhibits from Fine Arts, two exhibits from Needle Craft, two exhibits from Model Craft, and up to six exhibits from Any Other Crafts.

### **Requirements for All Classes and Exhibits at the Marion County Fair:**

1. Exhibit
2. Attach to each project the 4-H 618a-W 4-H Craft Information **This information card is for ALL Arts and Craft exhibits** even if it is not listed under the project.

### **For all arts and crafts exhibits:**

Level 1: Gr. 3-5

Level 2: Gr. 6-8

Level 3: Gr. 9 and up

Classes: Level 1 - Level 2 - Level 3

### **Miscellaneous Craft: Exhibit Requirements**

] Miscellaneous crafts are items made /decorated by hand. If a craft item fits the description of another project, it is NOT eligible for Miscellaneous Crafts. (Example: Drawings belong in Fine Arts and painted /decorated wooden projects belong in Woodcraft).

Attach to the exhibit the new 4-H 618a-W Craft Information Card.

4-Hers will exhibit in Miscellaneous Crafts according to age in categories of Levels 1, 2 and 3.

Miscellaneous Crafts may be crafts such as: enameling, candle making, felt craft, rock craft, weaving, stenciling, origami, reed craft, string art, metal etching, engraving, scrapbooking, plaster craft, handmade jewelry, paint by number, weaving, woven lawn chairs, etc.

4-H Members may enter up to three craft items in Miscellaneous Crafts in different media and techniques. On your label indicate the number of years you have worked in the specific craft.

Caution: Exhibits in the Miscellaneous Crafts category must be a craft that is created by the 4-H member. Legos, K'nex or other pre-made toys are not crafts and will not be accepted in this category.

Item/Exhibit must be ready to use.
