4-H Llama Poster

This project is to promote educational, creative, llama related 4-H exhibits. An educational exhibit about the selected topic should be designed to teach those who view the poster. Choose topics of interest to the 4-H'er, then apply your imagination. 4-H'ers are encouraged to seek assistance from their 4-H Llama program leaders, the county Extension Office staff and resources, the Internet, the Public Library and from other llama resources.

Categories:

Level 1 – grades 3, 4, & 5 (as of January 1 of current year)

Level 2 – grades 6, 7, & 8 (as of January 1 of current year)

Level 3 – grades 9, 10, 11, & 12 (as of January 1 of current year)



Exhibit Requirements:

1. Exhibit a poster (22" X 28") with stiff backing and a clear protective covering. Posters must be displayed horizontally and include exhibit label in lower right hand corner.
2. Poster topics can be anything relating to llamas. Suggestions of exhibit topics are listed below. Relate the title to your poster topic instead of using "Llama Poster" as the title.
3. Turn in a completed record sheet with your project.

Exhibit Topics:

The following suggestions are ideas for development of educational llama exhibits. 4-H'ers need not be limited to just these topics.

Level 1: Llama care, me and my llama, llama responsibilities, training my llama, nutrition.

Level 2: Purposes of llamas, responsible llama ownership, uses of llamas, disease/parasite prevention, conformation of your llama.

Level 3: Learning life skills with the llama project, food, animal health, animal welfare, reproduction.

Additional Ideas and Topics:

- Guard animals for smaller livestock.
- Shearing your llama. Why, how, and the best cut for your animal.
- The diet and nutrition of raising a healthy llama from cria to adult.
- Llamas belong to groups. What are the groups?
- General history of the llama family, camelid. How it began to the present day animal.
- A disease of llamas: its discovery, effects, treatments, etc.
- Some phase of llama training: companions, cart pulling, obstacles, pack, guard, etc. Whatever you choose, give a little history, theory, value, pertinence today.
- Explain the different wool types and their uses.
- A parasite of llamas: its discovery, treatment, effects, etc.
- Draw a diagram of a llama and label parts of the body and explain the function of each.
- Explain the nutritional requirements of a llama.
