GENERAL MINI 4-H RULES:

1. You must be in the 1st or 2nd grade at the time you sign up for this project.
2. You must enroll in the Mini 4-H Dog project.
3. Please read and follow project rules carefully. You will not be training or showing your dog but, you are encouraged to attend dog club meetings, workshops, and special shows.

COMPLETION GUIDELINES:

To complete your Mini 4-H Dog Project you must:

1. Complete an optional poster which **MUST** be displayed horizontally, measure 14” X22”, mounted on firm backing, covered with clear plastic and have a green mini 4-H exhibit label in the lower right hand corner.
2. See mini 4-H Dog manual for details and topics.
3. In addition to the optional poster - mini Dog project members are invited to assist the County Dog Club (Tailwaggers) by serving as Ring Stewards during the County 4-H Judging at the Fair. Your poster is to be turned in at the County Judging at the Fair.
1. Complete the Mini 4-H Dog record sheet and turn it in at the dog show at the 4-H Fair.
