

Marion County 4-H Exhibit Tags

On the following page are the 4-H exhibit tags for your township fair and to use as place holders. Exhibit tags for county and state fair will be generated and printed from the information you provide on fairentry.com. You will receive your county exhibit tags at project check in.

To start type in your first and last name in the box, then fill in the information on each line to create tags for each of your 4-H projects. “#Yrs” is the number of years you have completed work in this project area. Do not forget that you can use more than one tag if your exhibit has more than one piece. Create as many exhibit tags as you need. When you have finished completing the exhibit tag, print the page (Make sure your printer is set to print page 2 only), cut out your exhibit tags (Cut along black lines to the edge of the page, the exhibit tags generated for county and state fair take up the whole page) and fasten them securely to your 4-H exhibit.

If you are not sure about the number of years you have been in a project, the grade or division for your exhibit, check the online project description on our website, or double check with your 4-H leader to assure proper completion. If you prefer, you may simply print the blank forms and neatly print the information on the tags. You may print your tags in color or in black and white, either is acceptable. The areas to fill in the tags should be highlighted on your computer screen. If they are not, click the button labeled Highlight Fields in the upper right hand corner of the screen. Continue by typing in the highlighted areas.

Guidelines for placing exhibit tags

- ◆ If your project has more than one piece, put a tag on each piece.
- ◆ Avoid using adhesive tape directly on finished wood or leather surfaces. The heat and humidity at the fair may cause the adhesive to ruin the finished surface.
- ◆ Tags may be hole punched and tied to exhibits.
- ◆ Apply tags to clothing or fabric pieces using straight pins. Alternatively, punch two holes in the top of the tag and fasten to exhibit with an appropriately sized safety pin.
