

## Skill-a-thon Exhibition

4 Tables: Anatomy, Breed ID, Medication Directions/Label and Facility Management. Focus will be on Exhibition. You may answer extra questions at any table for extra credit.

Anatomy table: You will have to identify a predetermined amount of parts. You may not label the same part on different posters. For example: you cannot label the beak/bill on all five posters.

Beginner: Identify 15 parts and 2 comb types

Intermediate: Identify 20 parts and 4 comb types

Senior: Identify 25 parts and 6 comb types

Breed ID table: You will be identifying breeds, matching the description to the picture.

Beginner: Identify 5 breeds

Intermediate: Identify 10 breeds and 10 breed traits

Senior: Identify 15 breeds and 15 breed traits

Medication Label/Directions Table: You will be identifying parts of the label and answering questions on the directions.

Beginner: Identify 5 parts

Intermediate: Identify 10 parts, Answer 3 questions

Senior: Identify 15 parts Answer 6 questions

Facility Management Table: You will be looking at management of the barn.

Beginner: Identify 3 scenarios correctly

Intermediate: You will prepare the 4 scenarios, and give reasons for the placement

Senior: You will set up the 4 scenarios, give reasons for set up and answer 4 questions.

## Skill-a-thon Commercial

There will be 4 tables: Egg Judging, Medication Directions/Label, Carcass Cuts and Carcass Grades. This will focus on Commercial. You may answer extra questions at any table for extra credit.

Egg Exterior Quality Table: You will identify and grade the egg based on the picture:

Beginner: grade 5 eggs

Intermediate: grade 10 eggs

Senior: grade 15 eggs

Medication Direction/Label Table: Will need to identify and answer questions

Beginner: Identify 5 parts

Intermediate: Identify 10 parts and Answer 3 questions

Senior: Identify 15 parts and answer 6 questions

Carcass Cuts Table: You will identify carcass cuts

Beginner: Identify 5 cuts

Intermediate: Identify 10 cuts

Senior: Identify 15 cuts

Carcass Grading Table: You will grade pictures of carcass and answer questions

Beginner: Grade 5 carcass

Intermediate: Grade 8 carcasses and answer question #1

Senior: Grade 12 carcasses and answer question #1, 3
