Items You bring to workshops: (Found at Wal-Mart, Meijer, Michaels, etc.)

A star decorating tube #16, #18, OR #20 (ONE IS FINE!)
A leaf decorating tube #349 OR #352 (looks like a duck beak)
A writing tube #3 OR #4 would be good...if you can only find #2 that's fine as well
A box of wax paper
A batch of Buttercream icing (see attached recipe)
A pair of scissors
Tape
Butter knife
Something to decorate (cookie sheet, cake pan, real cake...but NOT necessary)
Your Cake decorating book (found in the Extension office)
And Wal-mart sack to put all of your messy stuff back in to take home to wash!
