You are cordially invited to participate in the Dearborn County Fashion Review. Projects exhibiting non-wearable sewing projects do not participate in the Fashion Review. Project members in Wearable Arts may choose to participate in the Fashion Review if you are making wearable garments (not jewelry).

Fashion Revue judging is completed prior to the public Fashion Revue during the fair. The Fashion Revue judging is May 30 beginning at 5:30 P.M. in Agner Hall, on the Lawrenceburg Fairgrounds.

The Public Fashion Revue held during fair week, is June 20 beginning at 5 P.M. on the Haag Ford Stage or Agner Hall (weather depending).

Consumer Clothing and Frugal Fashions members this is your project check in. Consumer Clothing & Frugal Fashions project members must bring their notebook to the Fashion Revue judging on May 30th. You will complete a short interview with the judge explaining your project. 4-H members in Consumer Clothing and Frugal Fashions need to arrive by 5 pm, in time for interview and notebook judging which begins at 5:30 PM.

Modeling tips will be presented at 6:15 P.M and at 6:30, Judging in Outfits begins. The review order, as stated in the handbook: Consumer Clothing, Frugal Fashions, Junior Sewing, Intermediate Sewing, Senior sewing, Wearable Arts, and Sewing for Fun and Others.


