GENERAL MINI 4-H RULES:

1. You must be in the 1st and 2nd grade at the time you sign up for this project.
2. You must enroll in the Mini 4-H Dog project.
3. Please read and follow project rules carefully. You will not be training or showing your dog but, you are encouraged to attend dog club meetings, workshops, and special shows.

COMPLETION GUIDELINES:

To complete your Mini 4-H Dog Project you must:

Complete an optional poster which **MUST** be displayed horizontally, 14" X 22", mounted on firm backing, covered in clear plastic and have a mini 4-H exhibit label in the lower right hand corner.

On the poster have a picture or drawing of your dog, or your favorite breed of dog, plus the following information:

- a) Breed
- b) Where originated
- c) Purpose of breed, or explain why this breed was developed
- d) What are the standards of the breed

If your dog is a "mixed breed" – describe the predominate breed – or you may choose to describe your favorite breed of dog.

Your leader has reference materials – books and magazines which can help you. If you do not understand or need help – PLEASE ASK!

In addition to the optional poster – Mini Dog Project members are expected to assist the County Dog Club (Tailwaggers) by serving as Ring Stewards during the County Club show in July and during the County 4-H Judging at the Fair. Your poster is to be turned in at the County Judging at the Fair.
