Dear Poultry Exhibitor Members and Families,

Thank you for enrolling in the Dearborn County 4-H poultry project. I look forward to your participation in the 4-H Poultry Project this year. You will be processing auction broiler market birds after the poultry show on Monday June 18, and presenting them at the auction on Friday night in a non-returnable cooler, with the processing invoice taped to the cooler. Please make your processing appointments to fit into this time frame.

Please Note: Every chicken or game bird showing at the fair has to either have a NPIP certification from a Pullorum-Typhoid free flock, (bird cannot be more than one year old), or **they have to be tested within 90 days of the fair.** Each bird blood tested will be accessed a \$1 fee to cover the cost of the antigen used in the testing. Ducks do not need to be tested or have a certificate.



Dearborn County 4-H Poultry Pen Entry Form

All project members should fill out and return this form to the extension office to participate in the fair.
Deadline is May 15 for all entries, project birds must be in your possession by this time.

Select only 1 from each category.

___ Pullets (two female birds under 1 year of age day of show)

___ Hens (two female birds 1 year old or more day of show)

___ Broilers (two meat type birds of the same sex, 6-8 weeks of age, between 2 1/2 and not over 5 1/2 pounds)

___ Roasters (two meat type birds of the same sex, 8-12 weeks of age, over 5 1/2 pounds and up to 10 pounds)

___ Bantam Exhibition Pullet, one pullet under 12 months of age, from a bantam breed

___ Bantam Exhibition Cockerel, one cockerel under 12 months of age, from a bantam breed

___ Bantam Exhibition Hen, one hen 1 year or more day of show, from a bantam breed

___ Bantam Exhibition Cock, one cock 1 year or more day of show, from a bantam breed

___ Large Fowl Exhibition Pullet, one pullet under 12 months of age, from a standard breed

___ Large Fowl Exhibition Cockerel, one cockerel under 12 months of age, from a standard breed

___ Large Fowl Exhibition Hen, one hen 1 year or more day of show, from a standard breed

___ Large Fowl Exhibition Cock, one cock 1 year or more day of show, from a standard breed

___ Market Duck (meat type duck weighing between 5 and 8 pounds and be less than six months old)

___ Exhibition Male Duck, any age

___ Exhibition Female Duck, any age

Turkey entries must supply their own cage on the ground. How many cages and what size are you bringing?

___ Market Eggs, a half dozen (6) brown shell eggs from your family flock

INDIANA POULTRY EXHIBITOR FORM

Indiana was certified a United States Pullorum-Typhoid Clean State on December 9, 1981.

In order to maintain this classification, we must comply with seven specific requirements.

One of these requirements pertains to exhibition poultry.

Therefore, by law, to exhibit your poultry must have either:

- ♦ *Originated **directly** from a National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP)
Pullorum-Typhoid certified clean flock **within one (1) year***

OR

- ♦ *Had a **negative** Pullorum-Typhoid test **within ninety (90) days** prior to exhibition*
