- ❖ 4-H Mini member, parent and animal in the same combination are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to participate in two Mini safety workshops.
- ❖ ASTM approved helmets, long pants and western boots with a heel must be worn at all times during workshops and the show.
- ❖ No uncontrollable animal will be allowed at the workshops or the show.
- ❖ Must follow the Mini 4-H Horse and Pony guidelines which are listed in the Morgan County 4-H Handbook.

Classes Offered:

1. Mini Safety Showmanship

* Parent/guardian must also have a lead rope on the animal in addition to the mini member's lead rope.

Mini 4-H members will enter the ring and turn to the right under the direction of the ring steward. The ring steward will then line them up side by side. One at a time, the Mini member will walk to the judge and set up for inspection. The judge will inspect the animal and then dismiss the member. The member will then walk in a straight line across the arena and line the animal up facing the center of the arena and wait to be dismissed.

2. Mini Lead Line

The Mini 4-H member must be mounted in a proper fitting saddle with stirrups adjusted to fit them. **Add on stirrups are not allowed.** The Mini member needs to have a bridle with reins on the animal. The parent or approved adult must have a lead on the animal and maintain control at all times.

Enter the ring at a walk, turn right. You will continue at a walk and wait for instructions from your ring steward. Listen to the announcer.
