

## Application for Standard 4-H Club Seal

Fill out in duplicate. Keep this copy in your book and send the other copy to the County Extension Office to apply for your seal.

Requirements for a "Standard 4-H Club" are listed below. State what your club has done to meet each of these requirements. If all requirements are met, your club will qualify as a "Standard 4-H Club". The first year that your club meets these requirements you will be given a Standard 4-H Club charter and seal. For each following year that your club meets Standard 4-H Club requirements you will be given a seal to be affixed to the charter.

If, in addition to meeting requirements for a Standard 4-H Club, your club meets the higher requirements, they will receive an honor seal.

1. There shall be a local leader in charge with such junior assistance as can be developed. Name of local leader \_\_\_\_\_
