Registration will begin at 6:00 p.m., and the program will run 6:30-8:30 p.m. Dr. Keith Johnson, Purdue forage specialist, will speak on problem weeds and weed control in pastures, and on understanding potato leafhopper and leafhopper-resistant alfalfa: can I reduce insecticide use?
