

Recycling (No State Fair Exhibit)

- Enroll in 4-H, pay annual program fee, and enter project in 4HOnline by May 15
- Enter exhibit(s) in FairEntry by last business day in June, which is June 28, 2019
- Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 20 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects.

All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author when using outside sources, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

Level 1: Grades 3, 4, 5

Level 2: Grades 6, 7, 8

Level 3: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

Exhibit Categories:

1. Poster Option
2. Artwork or home/household item option
3. Fashion Item

Project Requirements:

1. Poster Option-exhibit an educational poster on one of the topics listed. See Allen County General 4-H Rules: Poster Rule & Label Rule.
2. Artwork or home/household item option-exhibit artwork OR a home or household item created from recyclable products. Bonding agent does not need to be a recycled product.
3. For artwork or home/household exhibits, a list of all materials used must accompany the exhibit-list on record sheet.
4. If your Artwork or home/household items are larger than 36"x36"x36", to please let the Extension Office know at least a week before the fair. See Allen County General 4-H Rule, Poster Rule & Label Rule.
5. Recycling will be judged on workmanship, information provided, creativity and completed record sheet.
6. 4-H'er may exhibit a maximum of three (3) items from any of the categories.
7. Complete and exhibit a different item(s) each year.
