Welcome to Mini 4-H! You are now a member of the Whitley County 4-H family! We hope that you will have lots of fun learning new things in your 4-H career.

Mini 4-H is designed for youth in Kindergarten through Second grade. It will give you a taste of the 4-H program as well as help you to explore a variety of project areas.

This manual contains fun, age appropriate activities to complete throughout the 4-H year. These activities will help you to learn about the project you have chosen. Additionally, the manual contains all instructions for the exhibit you will be preparing for the Whitley County 4-H Fair in July.

There is no competition in the Mini 4-H program. Each child who completes a project for the Fair will receive the same completion ribbon. Leaders will give each project comment sheets are provided only as a way to help you do your very best on future projects.

Mini 4-H will meet January through June. Try to attend the as many meetings as you can they are planned especially for YOU! These will give you a chance to meet the leaders, have some hands-on fun, and ask questions about your important Fair display. Mini 4-H is FUN! You will enjoy it.

Once you enter the third grade you can join a regular 4-H club that meets monthly. You must enroll each year of your 4-H career.

As a Mini 4-H parent, please help guide and encourage your child through the activities. Work with them to help them to “learn by doing”. Activities are designed to help your child learn about the project they have chosen. It is not required that they complete all the activities. Choose those that interest you and your child.

Kindergarten Requirements

“All about me – ABC’s”

- 1) The scrapbook will be 8 x 8 inches. It can be post bound or strap hinge.
- 2) There must be a title page that includes “All About Me – ABC’s”
- 3) It will include letters A-H
- 4) All letters will present something about the 4-Header.
- 5) The scrapbook must be decorated with all acid-free products, including the paper.
- 6) There must be a title on each page. This can be handwritten, typed, stickers, etc...
- 7) One picture must be included on each page.
- 8) Exhibit tag must be on bottom right-hand corner of front cover.
- 9) Record sheet must be folded and put in last page of scrapbook.

“All about me – ABC’s”

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1st Grade Requirements

- 1) The scrapbook will be 8 x 8 inches. It can be post bound or strap .
- 2) There must be a title page that includes “All About Me – ABC’s”
- 3) It will include letters I-P.
- 4) All letters will present something about the 4-H'er.
- 5) The scrapbook must be decorated with all acid-free products, including the paper.
- 6) There must be a title on each page. This can be handwritten, typed, stickers, etc...
- 7) One matted picture must be included on each page. A mat is colored paper behind the picture that outlines the picture in the same shape.
- 8) Each page must include on sentence describing the picture. This sentence must be handwritten (parents can help spell and this will show personality)
- 9) Exhibit tag must be on bottom right-hand corner of front cover.

Record Sheet must be folded and put in last page of scrapbook.

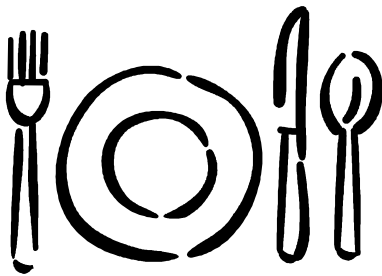
****Please Note – Requirements are only letters I – P, but the 4-H'er may want to complete A – H if they weren't in the project last year.***** “All about me – ABC’s”

2nd Grade Requirements

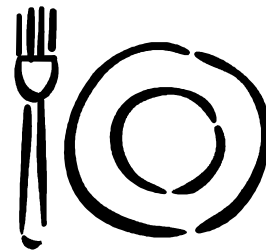
The scrapbook will be 8 x 8 inches. It can be post bound or strap hinge.

- 1) There must be a title page that includes "All About Me – ABC's"
- 2) It will include letters Q-Z.
- 3) All letters will present something about the 4-H'er.
- 4) The scrapbook must be decorated with all acid-free products, including the paper.
- 5) There must be a title on each page. This can be handwritten, typed, stickers, etc...
- 6) Two cropped pictures must be included on each page. Cropping is centering the main object of the picture. See example below.
- 7) Each page must include two to three sentences describing the picture. This sentence must be handwritten (parents can help spell and this will show personality)
- 8) Exhibit tag must be on bottom right-hand corner of front cover.
- 9) Record sheet must be folded and put in last page of scrapbook.

****Please note-requirements are only letters Q-Z, but the 4-Her may want to complete A-P if they weren't in this project last year. ****
