Have you ever thought about going on a 4-H trip? Attending 4-H trips is fun and educational. There are many opportunities for you to travel and meet 4-Hers from all over Indiana as well as the USA.

You must apply if you are interested in attending any of the trips. Attached is a description of all the trips available in 2019 and the application form, which is **due March 1, 2019**. All applications **must** be turned into the Extension Office. **DO NOT** enroll yourself through 4HOnline.

You may only attend 4-H Round-up and Citizenship Washington Focus one time. If you attend 4-H Academy @ Purdue more than once, you must choose a different workshop each time.


For 4-H Round-Up and 4-H Academy @ Purdue Whitley County may share bus transportation with other counties. Transportation to all other trips must be provided by the 4-Her's family.

Some trips may require an additional application. If so, you will be sent the necessary information to complete the application process.

You will receive a letter of acceptance for the trip(s) you are selected to attend with the cost of each trip. You will be responsible for paying the total amount by the due date noted on the trip acceptance letter.

Sponsorship money is available from 4-H Clubs, Inc. and/or 4-H Council that you may request **after** you have received a letter notifying you have been selected for trip(s). Contact information for making request(s) is included in your notification letter. If you want to seek other sponsorships from your 4-H club, friends or family, you are free to do so. .

4-H trips are available for 4-Hers grades 3 –12. Each trip is unique, educational and fun and you will make lifelong friends. If you have any questions, please call or email.
