Lake County 4-H Junior Leaders

4-H members in grade 7 and above may enroll in the 4-H Junior Leaders. This program focuses on the development of leadership skills as well as service learning and fellowship. Members assist with club and county 4-H activities. Junior Leaders meet monthly and plan a variety of things to do.

Recent activities included a midnight Lock-In, a pizza party for 4-H adult volunteers, a trip to a waterpark in Wisconsin, and a trip to Monticello for Indiana Beach/Madam Carroll Junior Leader Day. Junior Leaders are encouraged to participate in state 4-H activities such as the State Junior Leader Conference and Indiana 4-H Youth Congress. The Junior Leaders earn funds for their activities by operating a concessions stand at 4-H project judging and selling ice cream during the county fair.

An ongoing service project is collecting new and gently used books for distribution to children who visit the county health department for immunizations.

Junior Leaders have completed trips/events to celebrate all the members who've completed for the year. This year we went to Enchanted Castle located in Lombard Illinois.

There are several committees within the Lake County 4-H Club Committee:

Adult Leaders Committee

All currently enrolled 4-H volunteers are encouraged to participate in this committee which meets once a month. This committee addresses the concerns of 4-H clubs and opportunities for 4-H members. The committee maintains a treasury which is used for livestock projects and volunteer development. Meetings are generally held on the third Tuesday of the month. Each club is asked to have at least one representative present at each meeting. This committee also is responsible for appointing two of the County Committee Directors.

Horse & Pony Leaders Committee

This committee consists of all Horse & Pony club leaders, assistant club leaders, and project leaders. The committee coordinates the Lake County 4-H Horse & Pony program and addresses concerns of Horse & Pony 4-H clubs and the 4-H Horse Bowl, Hippology, Judging, and Drill Teams. The committee's treasury is used to support the 4-H Horse & Pony program. Each Horse & Pony club is asked to have at least one representative present at each meeting. The committee is responsible for appointing two of the County Committee Directors.

Auction Committee

The Auction Committee consists of all livestock project superintendents (Beef, Dairy, Dairy Steer, Goat, Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep, and Swine) and is open to all other enrolled volunteers. The committee is responsible for carrying out the 4-H Livestock Auction and maintains a treasury for this purpose. The Auction Committee appoints two of the County Committee Directors.

Our 4-H adult volunteers are essential in helping youth make the most of these learning opportunities.

The Lake County 4-H Club Committee, Inc. (County Committee) is the governing body of the Lake County 4-H program. County Committee consists of all enrolled Lake County 4-H adult volunteers. Responsibilities of County Committee include needs assessment and program planning, member recruitment, volunteer development and recognition, and financial support for programming. The Committee also assures that county 4-H policies are consistent with state and national policies and resolves conflicts relating to these policies.

County Committee coordinates our county-level 4-H awards and the 4-H Ambassador Program and also organizes 4-H Achievement Night during the Lake County Fair and the annual Leadership Recognition Banquet. The Committee is responsible for county-wide fundraising efforts like the annual Geranium Sale, 4-H Night at the RailCats, spiritwear, and the 4-H Fun, Food, and Fellowship Chicken Dinner. This income supports local programming and sponsors members and adult volunteers who attend events like 4-H Round-Up, the State Junior Leader Conference, 4-H Academy @ Purdue, Citizenship Washington Focus, Eastern National 4-H Horse & Pony Round-Up, and the Global Gateway Experience.

The work of the Committee is coordinated by an elected Board of Directors, consisting of up to eighteen 4-H adult volunteers and two 4-H Junior Leaders. The Board of Directors meets monthly at the Extension Office. All 4-H volunteers, parents/guardians, and members are welcome to attend and may request to be included on the agenda.
