Dubois County classes are held at the TRI-CAP Office located at 607 3rd Avenue, Jasper, IN.

One session Saturday classes are scheduled from 8AM until NOON. Two session weeknight classes are scheduled for from 6PM until 8PM. You must complete four hours of education to receive your certificate.

Co-Parenting for Successful Kids strengthens communication skills that can improve interactions with children and the other parent. Parents will learn to answer children's questions and to keep children safe and out of adult conflicts. The goal of the class is to support parents to become more respectful, responsive, and responsible.
