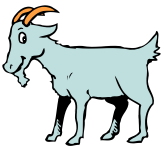

2019 Goat Workshop and ID Clinic Dates

Feb. 17 4:00 p.m. at the Fairgrounds (WKR) Goat Club meeting
March 17 4:00 p.m. at the Fairgrounds (WKR) Goat Club meeting
April TBD
May 8 4:00-6:00 p.m., County Goat ID Clinic, Morgan County 4-H Fairgrounds, Swine building
Costs: county tags \$1.00, eye scan (State Fair entries only) \$2.00
Animals requiring a 5 digit county tag must be tagged at the County Tagging/Weigh-In
If a tattoo is needed, tattoo pliers will be at the ID clinic for members to tattoo their own animals.



All goats, except wethers, under 18 months of age are required to have a scrapie tag or tattoo (See Morgan County 4-H Handbook goat rules).

The worksheet enclosed will need to be completed and a copy retained at weigh-in.

After weigh in follow the instructions below:

- **All Goats must be entered into 4HOnline not later than May 12th**
- Prior to the information being put into 4-H Online. (Please use the instruction sheet and worksheet provided for your records and go to <https://in.4honline.com>.

June 18 6:30-7:30 p.m., Goat Workshop - Fairgrounds, Show Arena, hands on, bring your goat.

June 25 6:30-7:30 p.m., Goat Workshop – Fairgrounds, Show Arena, hands on, bring your goat.

Youth for Quality Care of Animals (YQCA)

Members exhibiting meat or dairy animals at the county and state fairs are required to complete the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals training, either in-person or online at www.yqca.org. You must sign up for the training at this website BEFORE you come to it. In-person trainings are all held at the Morgan County Administration Building (where the Extension Office is located) in the Sadler Room at 6:30 p.m. In-person trainings are as follows:

April 11th, May 22nd, May 30th and June 27th

You can call the Extension Office at 765-342-1010 for a coupon code (this coupon code only applies for the leader led session) to defray the cost of \$3.00.
