TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Posters must be displayed horizontally, sized 22" x 28", mounted on a firm backing (foam-core board or other), and covered in clear plastic or other transparent material. Refer to 4-H Poster Guidelines.

EXHIBITS

DIVISION 1: Grades 3 - 4

1. Your completed workbook.
2. A poster relating to your project.

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

- Poster with a picture showing the parts of a horse.
- Poster with pictures showing different breeds of horses.
- Poster with pictures showing different colors of horses.

DIVISION 2: Grades 5 - 6

1. Your completed workbook.
2. A poster relating to your project.

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

- A poster showing tack with information about each piece.
- A poster showing gait of the horse.
- A horse poster showing and explaining items used in proper grooming.

DIVISION 3: Grades 7 - 8

1. Your completed workbook.
2. A poster relating to your project.

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

- A poster giving training information.
- A poster showing hoof structure.
- A poster showing and explaining items used in proper foot care.
- A poster relating to horse safety.

DIVISION 4 and ABOVE - Grades 9 - 12

1. Your completed workbook.
2. A poster relating to your project.

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

- A poster showing anatomy.
- A poster showing examples of unsoundness.
- A poster showing and explaining the horse digestive system.
- A poster showing life cycles of internal parasites.
