



2019 4-H Flower Sale Enthusiast!

The 4-H Flowers Fundraiser has supported activities for members for 37 years in Morgan County. Trips, camp expenses, fair expenses, conference registrations and leader resources are just a few of the things that this fundraiser puts wheels under within the 4-H program. Please consider promoting and selling colorful 4-H flowers to be part of this important effort.

1. Who should I ask to buy flowers?

Ask family members, bus drivers, teachers, neighbors, friends from your church and other groups you belong to.

2. What plant sizes are we selling?

This year's expanded lineup includes single plants in 4.5 inch pots, hanging baskets in 10-inch baskets (HB) and combination planters in 12-inch biodegradable pots that you can plant in the ground or in a larger container. We have a **great** selection of plants for sun or partial sun! Look for the sun and clouds graphics on the different varieties of flowers on the photo page.

3. Prices are easy to remember!

4.5-inch plants sell for \$4.00 each

OR

Flat of 10 plants for \$35.00

10 inch Hanging Baskets (HB) sell for \$20.00 each

12 inch Combination (Combo) planters sell for \$30.00 each

The Morgan County 4-H Council and your club receive part of the proceeds from each sale.

Payment is collected when you sell the flowers.

4. Sale Dates are as follows:

Members should contact your leader with your plant totals and money (be specific--see the enclosed order form) by **Wednesday, April 10th**.

5. Club leaders- IMPORTANT!

Club leaders should call their total club orders to the Extension Office by **Friday, April 12th**.

6. When should I tell people the flowers arrive?

Delivery day is **Friday, April 26th** at the Morgan County Fairgrounds (Swine Barn) from

Noon to 6:00 p.m. **Leaders should pick up their flowers for the club. Bring a copy of your order to the fairgrounds on this day with the money collected. Your total club's order payment is due at this time to the 4-H Council.**

7. How do we care for the flowers?

Care instructions for flowers are included on the color photo page. Our frost-free date is May 10th, so remind your customers to protect their flowers in the event of frost.
