Junior Leader Purpose:

Who is Eligible:

1. 4-H members who are currently in Grades 7 – 12 and Hendricks County 4-H members.
2. Enrolled in the 4-H Junior Leader project.

Requirements for all 4-H Junior Leaders to complete:

1. Complete county and local activities for the project.
2. Assist with fair activities as needed.
3. Complete the 4-H Junior Leader Manual and turn it in to the Extension Office by *Friday, July 19, 2019*.
4. The above requirements are also required before a 4-H Junior Leader is allowed to go on the 4-H Junior Leader Completion Trip or receive 4-H Junior Leader Awards.
