

Jennings County Poultry Requirements

(Please note: Mini 4-H members (grades K-2) are encouraged to borrow another 4-H member's poultry bird already enrolled in the fair to use for Mini showmanship classes. If a Mini 4-H member wants to bring their own poultry to the fair to use for a showmanship class, the bird **MUST** meet the Animal ID requirements listed below. Please contact the Extension Office for more information)

Animal ID Requirements

All birds must be banded at the scheduled Animal ID Day.

All birds must come from a NPIP certified Pullorum-Typhoid clean flock or have had a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days prior to exhibition, and have appropriate paperwork showing proof.

You MUST show your NPIP certificate from the place you purchased your birds. For example, Tractor Supply should give you a certificate that states that your birds were purchased from a NPIP certified facility. If you do not bring this certificate with you, your birds will be tested at Animal ID Day.

Animal ID Day

ALL poultry **MUST** attend the Animal ID Day on **Thursday, May 16 from 5-7 pm** at Sand Creek Elementary School parking lot. See map. Please complete the enclosed forms and bring them with you to the Animal ID Day.

Online Animal ID

Poultry **DO NOT** need to enter animal ID information into 4HOnline, however you will enter your poultry information into Fairentry. For more information, contact Melessa Wiesehan at 812-352-3033.

Retagging

In the case of the loss of a poultry leg band, the County Extension Office must be notified immediately to schedule a time for the new tag to be replaced.

State Fair

To exhibit at the Indiana State Fair, 4-H families must complete a separate Indiana State Fair Entry in addition to the Indiana 4-H Online Animal ID.
