

Jennings County Rabbit Requirements

(Please note: Mini 4-H members (grades K-2) are encouraged to borrow another 4-H member's animal already enrolled in the fair to use for Mini showmanship classes. If a Mini 4-H member wants to bring their own animal to the fair to use for a showmanship class, the animal **MUST** meet all Board of Animal Health requirements. Please contact the Extension Office for more information)

Animal ID Requirements

4-H Rabbits must have a legible ear tattoo in the rabbit's left ear.

Animal ID Day

ALL rabbit project participants must turn in Enrollment Forms at the Animal ID Day on **Thursday, May 16 from 5-7 pm** at Sand Creek Elementary School. See map. The only rabbits that **MUST** be brought to Animal ID Day are those still needing a tattoo AND rabbits participating in the county bred, born and raised class. These participants must bring the mother and offspring to Animal ID Day.

Please complete the enclosed forms and bring them with you to the Animal ID Day. **All rabbit Enrollment Forms MUST be turned in on Animal ID Day even if you do not have to bring your rabbit to the Animal ID Day.**

Online Animal ID

Rabbits **DO NOT** need to enter animal id information into 4HOnline, however you will enter your rabbit information into Fairentry. For more information, contact Melessa Wiesehan at 812-352-3033.

To exhibit at the Indiana State Fair, 4-H families must complete a separate Indiana State Fair Entry in addition to the Indiana 4-H Online Animal ID.
