EACH market animal exhibit from the following departments: **Beef Cattle, Swine, Sheep, Dairy Goat Wethers and Meat Goats** entered at the Franklin County 4-H Fair must be listed on a 4-H Animal Affidavit. Use multiple copies if needed. **All family members living in the same household (i.e. siblings) may be listed on one form per species.** Exhibitors of all other animals may be required to complete and sign the animal affidavit at any time.

I (we) hereby certify that:

1. My (our) 4-H animals have not been maintained at a professional fitter’s facility and has been in my (our) continuous ownership since the date indicated in Indiana 4-H Online.
2. The exhibitor(s) and the exhibitor's parents and/or legal guardians agree that they are the people absolutely responsible for the care and custody of their animals in preparation for and while at the Franklin County 4-H Fair; including, but not limited to, policies regarding drug use and animal well-being.
3. The exhibitor(s) is (are) Youth Pork Quality Assurance Plus (PQA) Certified (swine only).
4. I (we) am (are) responsible for adhering to withdrawal times on all drugs administered to my (our) animal(s); only giving my (our) animal(s) FDA approved drugs; and keeping my (our) animal(s) free of illegal drugs prior to and during the Franklin County 4-H Fair. I (we) also understand that listing any substance on this form that violates the Terms and Conditions does not release me from the penalties associated with the violation.
5. My (our) submission of a 4-H entry expressly binds me to all terms and conditions contained in any and all parts of the Franklin County 4-H Fair Rule Book, to include, but not limited to, consent to drug, steroid, tissue tests, examination of my animal's carcass and insertion of a microchip or ear tag for identification as a condition of entering the fair.

1. Affidavit - a written statement of fact which is sworn to as the truth before an authorized officer.
 2. (Indiana Code 15-2.1-21-9) - A person who knowingly or intentionally violates or fails to comply with this article commits a Class D Felony.**(5)**
 3. Perjury - knowingly making a false material statement under oath or affirmation. In Indiana, a person who commits perjury commits a Class D felony **(5)**, which may be punishable by imprisonment, fine or restitution. (Indiana Code 35-44-2-1 and 35-50-2-7).
