Just a reminder that all registered Dairy heifers you wish to show at the 2019 Hamilton County 4-H Fair must be enrolled by **May 15, 2019**. To enroll your registered Dairy heifers you need to complete the 4-H Dairy ID enrollment at <https://in.4honline.com>. Enclosed is an instruction sheet to help walk you through the process. If you need assistance, the Extension Office will have computers set up for the public to use.


**All dairy heifers must have an RFID tag. These can be picked up at the Extension Office.**

**Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA):** 4-H'ers planning to exhibit beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, poultry and rabbits **MUST BE CERTIFIED** through YQCA. This is an annual program that can be completed via online modules or in-person trainings. See enclosed flyer for more information.


**Note:** Pure Bred Registration papers must be presented at check-in prior to unloading at the fair. The Board of Animal Health (BOAH) is not requiring participants to have animal health forms for the county and state fair. Animals will be physically inspected prior to entering the barn and may be rejected or removed due to health issues at any time during the Fair.
