Project Requirements

Complete 4-H Crops Records pages 1 & 2.

Exhibit Requirements

* In order to be considered a crops project (as opposed to a garden project), plot must be a minimum of 1 acre.

Judge considers following criteria when judging soybeans:

1. Exhibit three (3) plants with roots, dirt washed off roots, Crops Information Card attached.
2. Uniform size of plants based on seeds per acre planted.
3. Uniform number of pods.
4. Stage of development for maturity planted.
5. Root system development.
6. Color of plant indicating ample nutrients available.
7. Insect or disease damage.
8. Population as indicated on crop info card - too heavy or too light for row width indicated.
9. Date of planting for maturity planted.
10. Complete 4-H Crops Record, (4-H 626), and Crops Information Card.
