

Hay Coring is at the 4-H Fairgrounds Clover Pavilion from 3-6 p.m. on **Thursday, June 20.** This will be a “drive thru” service. Please bring an entire bale, any size or shape.

Be prepared to tell us the type of hay... Grass, Legume, or Mixed (combination of grass and legume).

There will be a \$9.25 charge for each core sample, covering lab analysis fees. Remember that hay testing higher than 20% moisture content will be docked one ribbon grade.

You should include your hay project on the “**General 4-H Record Sheet**”. These will be collected at hay coring or at check in of fair and are **required for project completion**. If hay is your only project for 2019, you should turn in your “General 4-H Record Sheet” during hay coring. A one to two paged report on the effects of the weather conditions on your project, the goals you had for your project, and what you did to try to meet the exhibit requirements can be submitted if a sample cannot be taken. **This report is due Thursday, June 20th.** Bring it to the fairgrounds during hay coring times or to the Extension Office by 4:00 p.m.
