The 4-H Fashion Revue is an educational activity for those 4-H members enrolled in the Sewing Project. It is an optional activity.

Fashion Revue places emphasis on selecting, constructing, accessorizing, and modeling garments which compliment the participant and fit well with the total wardrobe.

Judging

Both Junior and Senior participants have the opportunity to be judged (Mini Members WILL NOT be judged).

Note: Consumer Clothing Judging will also be taking place at the same location.

Public Fashion Revue

All sewing members, including Minis, are encouraged to participate in the Public Fashion Revue to be held Tuesday, July 23 at 7:00 pm in the Show Barn at the Allen County Fairgrounds. There will be a runway set up so you will not have to walk on mulch in the arena. You will be able to change in the bathrooms in the Exhibit Buildings. You will find the Registration Form enclosed, which needs to be filled out in full for Fashion Revue. **THIS REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE TURNED BY JUNE 28TH. You will need to also enter in the FairEntry system.**

When you check in your sewing items at the Fair, please bring them in a clear plastic garment bag. Dry cleaner bags are fine.

Each sewing entry MUST have one (1) Sewing Exhibit Card attached, regardless of number of articles. You will need a separate card for wearable and non-wearable exhibits. The card is available on our website at www.extension.purdue.edu/allen. Hover over 4-H Youth Development, then click 4-H Projects – Allen County, then Sewing, then your grade and you will see the Sewing Exhibit Cards in the same link with the record sheet for your grade.

Please read the enclosed information carefully. Refer to the Allen County 4-H Rules Book Sewing section for a description of Divisions/Categories. Senior Division, outfit must be complete specific to your category, see the Allen County 4-H Rules Book. 4-H FASHION REVUE INSTRUCTIONS

(Please read carefully)

I. Who is eligible?

Junior Fashion Revue – 4-H'ers enrolled in grade 3 -7 in the Sewing Project
Senior Fashion Revue - 4-H'ers enrolled in grades 8-12 in the Sewing Project

II. What is to be modeled?

Garments modeled must have been made by the contestant since the 2018 Allen County Fair.
County Rules allow you to enter one (1) garment in Fashion Revue and a different garment in Sewing Wearable, or you may enter the same garment in both.

III. Pre-registration

Please fill out completely the enclosed registration form. Be sure to include a sample piece of material.
You will also enter yourself on Fair Entry.

RETURN by June 28, 2019 to the Extension Office.

IV. Fashion Revue Judging

To be held Monday, July 8, 2019 at Allen County Extension Office.

Seniors - Registration at 4:30 p.m. Judging begins at 5:00 p.m.

Juniors – Registration at 5:00 p.m. Judging begins at approximately 5:30 p.m.

You will receive your judging number - which is to be worn on the right knee. There will be a changing area and a restroom available for your use.

Order for judging will be Senior Fashion Revue (grades 8-12), Suits and coats, Formal wear, Dress-up wear, Separates, Free choice, Informal/casual wear followed by Junior Fashion Revue (grades 3-7). Juniors are welcome and encouraged to watch the Seniors so they have a chance to see what they can expect. This will hopefully alleviate some anxiety. Remember – this is a FUN activity!

You will come out and stand in groups. You will then model one at a time in order of your numbers. When you are finished modeling, stand in front of the judges. They may ask you to turn around to face them. They will signal when they are done - return to your group. When your entire group is done you may leave the judging area. When your entire division or category has been judged you are free to leave.

V. Public Fashion Revue

The public Fashion Revue will be held Tuesday, July 23 at 7:00 pm in the Show Barn at the Allen County Fairgrounds. There will be a runway set up so you will not have to walk on mulch in the arena. You will be able to change in the bathrooms in the Exhibit Buildings. You will find the Registration Form enclosed, which needs to be filled out in full. **THIS REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE TURNED IN WITH YOUR NOTEBOOK ON JUNE 28TH. Important Note: YOU MUST BE DRESSED, CHECKED IN AND IN LINE BY 6:45 P.M. If you choose to be judged in Fashion Revue, you must also participate in Public Fashion Revue. You must also exhibit in the Sewing Project.**

The Public Fashion Revue will run in the following order.

4-H Consumer Clothing, Allen County Open Class, 4-H Minis, 4-H Juniors, 4-H Seniors

Seniors choosing to participate in Fashion Revue judging and the Public Fashion Revue are eligible to receive ribbons and may be selected to represent Allen County at the State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue.
