Dear Mini 4-H Member (Grades K-2 as of January 1, 2019)

It's soon going to be fair time in Morgan County! Hopefully you are working on some very creative Mini 4-H projects in between the many summer activities you're enjoying. This letter is a summary of Mini 4-H activities and classes available for kids like you. We ask that you complete the form enclosed and return it to the Extension Office. In addition please contact the superintendent as specified to express your interest. Read carefully and keep this letter handy between now and the fair. ****PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FAIR DATES ARE JULY 26 –AUGUST 3. Please pay close attention to the dates and times of the events as some of the events are prior to the fair.**

1. **Mini 4-H Pet Parade:** This is your opportunity as a Mini 4-H member (those who have completed Grades K-2) to show off your pet at the Morgan County Fair. The parade will be held on **Sunday, July 28 at 1:00 p.m. beginning at the Antique Machinery Building on the fairgrounds**, and it is sponsored by the *Morgan County Junior Leaders and St. Francis Pet Hospital-Centerton Office*. Enclosed is a copy of the rules and an entry form. All entry forms and animal health forms must be turned into the Extension Office by Friday, June 14, 2019. (4-H Dog and Cat require Vaccination forms which are available in the Extension Office or you can obtain a copy from the website at www.extension.purdue.edu/morgan. Poultry requires a blood test certificate. Please call the Extension Office at 765-342-1010 if have questions.) There are no ribbons or premium money involved in this activity, but it is very enjoyable for the participants, their families, and fairgoers. Various pet-related prizes will be given away in goody bags at the end of the parade. If you are interested in this activity, please read over the rules carefully, fill out the enclosed form and return it to the Extension Office by June 14.

This activity is open to enrolled **Mini 4-H Second Graders only (currently completed 2nd grade before the county fair)** interested in showing a pig at the Morgan County Fair. **It is strongly suggested that Mini members attend the Swine Showmanship Workshop.** You will use another 4-H member's pig, so **do not bring a pig to the fair.** Mini 4-H members will be paired with an older member who will assist them during the show.

You may use a goat of your own as long as you have made arrangements with the Goat Superintendent. If you do not have a goat of your own, a goat will be provided for you. Mini 4-H'ers will be paired with a regular 4-H Goat member who will assist them during the show. If you have any questions, please contact Patty Dow, Morgan County 4-H Goat Superintendent at (765-537-2010). **You are very strongly encouraged to attend at least one Goat workshop before you show a goat.**

1. Sign Liability Release form
 2. Mini 4-Her and animal must be under parent/guardian supervision at all times
 3. No mini 4-Her with an uncontrollable or unsafe llama will be allowed to participate in workshops or in the show. This will be determined by the leader.
 4. Parent will accompany mini 4-Her at all times when animal is out of the pen at show and use a double lead with the animal to and from the show ring. In the show ring the parent must remain with child, but no added lead.
 5. Leaders and/or senior 4-Hers also will be in the show ring to help.
 6. Proper footwear is required at all times, workshops and show: Tennis shoes or boots. No flip flops or sandals allowed.
 7. Mini 4-Hers will have 2 categories at show. Showmanship and obstacle course.

This is an activity for any Mini 4-H member (currently in Grades K-2 before the county fair.) The participant may bring a chicken or duck from home or borrow one from an older sibling. If bringing from home, the chicken/duck may be a cross or a purebred and must go home after showing. Participant will be judged on their knowledge of the bird and their ability to handle the bird. All participants will receive a multi-colored ribbon. All out of state chickens must be accompanied with an NPIP certificate showing that it is Pullorium-Typhoid clean.

This is an activity for **any Mini 4-H member (currently in Grades K-2 before the county fair)**. The 4-H'er must be able to handle a rabbit in order to participate in a Mini Rabbit class at the county fair. This class is not considered a project, but an opportunity for Mini members to experience a rabbit show. You may bring your own rabbit, or find an older 4-H Rabbit member who will allow you to use their rabbit in the Mini class. **You must make these arrangements yourself ahead of time.** Mini members may be assisted by an older member during the show.

This is an activity for **any Mini 4-H member (currently in Grades K-2 before the county fair)**. The adult leader in charge of this class will pair the Mini member with a regular 4-H member who will provide the lamb for this class. The Mini member is strongly encouraged to attend the sheep workshop. If a Mini member is unable to attend the workshop, then arrangements must be made with the adult leader in charge of this class for you to provide the name of the 4-H member's sheep you have permission to use during the show. The sheep class will be held at the Morgan County Fair during the 4-H Sheep Show. The member will lead the lamb with a sheep halter. Special consideration will be given to the temperament and ease of handling the lamb. Quality of the animal will not be judged. The lamb should be calm and lead quietly.

This is an activity for any Mini 4-H member (currently in Grades K-2 before the county fair). A mini member is allowed to show **ONE** of the following: bird, gerbil, grade rabbit, guinea pig, hamster, mouse/rat or hermit crab at the show. All Small Animals must remain in their cage at all times. The member will bring the cage to the judging table. All mini members will receive the same placing and the same color of ribbon. The Morgan County Livestock Committee will have the final determination of any problem or question.
