Swine Set Up & Tagging

Swine set up of gates will be June 27 at 6 pm. All swine will be tagged at check-in June 29th. There will be a \$3.00 fee required per tag.

Livestock Release Time

Livestock that are not going to excess or in the auction will be released July 4th from 6 pm - 8 pm or July 5th from 5 am - 7am.

You must stop at the brick building in front of the park to make sure you have all of your record sheets and YQCA training completed.

The size will be no larger than 22 x 28 (poster board size) You may use a tri-fold display board, if you would like. However, precautions will be taken to ensure your display remains intact.

Project References

All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

2019 State Fair Check-in

During the release of projects, July 5th from 4-6 pm, all 4-H'ers who were awarded State Fair entries will receive a letter with dates and instructions on when your projects need to go to the State Fair.

Projects (except for flowers, garden, or foods) need to be brought into the Extension Office no later than Thursday, July 25. Families taking their own projects to the State Fair may do so on July 28th from 3-7 pm and July 29th from 8 am -5 pm.

Foods, flowers, and garden projects need to be into the Extension Office between 7-8 am on July 1 or before. Please make sure all food projects have the 5x7 State Fair Recipe Card covered in plastic.

All projects need to be packaged for safe travels. Anything larger than 24 inches in length and width need to be transported by the owner. The Extension office is not responsible for assembling any projects in any way or form.

- **All CRAFT** projects will need a 4-H Craft Information Card. If you are not sure if your project requires one, contact the office.
- All 4-H projects need to be picked up on **Friday, July 5th from 4–6 PM.**

Online enrollment for Indiana State Fair 4-H & Open Livestock Shows

Indiana State Fair is utilizing an online entry system again this year for all Indiana State Fair entries. The online entry can be accessed by going to: <https://exhibitorscorner.indianastatefair.com/>

State Fair Animal Deadline

Livestock showing at the State Fair can enter all the way up to the State Fair, but the department fee will increase significantly. The original department fee deadlines are as follows:

2019 Deadlines for Beef, Swine, Sheep, Pygmy & Meat Goats

- *Enter between March 1-June 1 the department fee is \$20; per class entry fee is \$3
- *Enter between June 2-July 31 the department fee is \$70; per class entry fee is \$6
- *Enter between August 1-..... department fee \$120; per class entry fee is \$12
 - *Beef Cattle entry closes August 2
 - *Pygmy Goat entry closes August 2
 - *Meat Goat Entry closes August 6
 - *Sheep entry closes August 7
 - *Swine entry closes August 8

All livestock, except Pygmy Goats, will have a \$5 drug testing fee per animal

2019 Deadline for Horse & Pony, Cats, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Dog & Poultry

- *Enter between March 1-July 1 department fee is \$20; per class entry fee is \$3
- *Enter between July 2-July 31 department fee is \$70; per class entry fee is \$6
- *Enter between August 1.... department fee \$120; per class entry fee is \$12
 - *Dog entry closes July 24
 - *Cat entry closes August 5, with a \$5 cage fee
 - *Poultry entry closes August 6, with class fee increasing by \$1, \$2 and \$4
 - *Dairy Cattle entry closes August 10, with \$5 drug testing fee
 - *Dairy Goats entry closes August 16, with \$5 drug testing fee

2019 Deadline for Rabbits

- *Enter between March 1-July 1 department fee \$20; per class entry fee is \$1
- *Enter between March 2- July 30 department fee \$70; per class entry fee is \$2
