Indiana was certified a United States Pullorum-Typhoid Clean State on December 9, 1981.

In order to maintain this classification, we must comply with 7 specific requirements.

One of these requirements pertains to exhibition poultry.

Therefore, by law, to exhibit, your poultry must have either:

- *originated directly from a National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) Pullorum-Typhoid certified clean flock within one year*

or

- *had a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within ninety (90) days prior to exhibition.*

*Cornish-Cross Meat Birds do NOT need to be tested since they come from NPIP Hatcheries. Animals that are UNDER one year of age (pullets and cockerels) do NOT need to be blood tested as long as you purchased them from a NPIP approved distributor. ALL animals that are over one year of age MUST be blood tested prior to the 4-H fair. Ducks do not require NPIP Testing.

*I will come to your residence/farm to do any necessary blood testing a week or two before fair.
