Dear Regular and Mini 4-H Bicycle Project Members:

If you have signed up for the Bike rodeo project this letter is for you!

The County 4-H Bicycle Rodeo will be Friday, July 26, at 8:00 a.m.

Near the food court (Beef /Sertoma stand) on the Morgan County 4-H Fairgrounds.

We ask that you bring your bike and helmet. There will be a bicycle safety check done for proper height, mechanical function, tire inflation, etc. prior to the bicycle rodeo.

At the County Bicycle Rodeo you will be scored on the following:

- 1. Maintenance and safety check of bicycle
- 2. Safety while at the rodeo
- 3. Bicycle operation on obstacle courses

All **regular** 4-Her's will also be scored on written exam and quiz questions (including knowledge of tools and parts of the bicycle).



There are three categories:

MINI: Contestants must have completed Grades K, 1 or 2 during the '18-'19 school year.

JUNIOR: Contestants must have completed Grades 3-7 during the '18-'19 school year.

SENIOR: Contestants must have completed Grades 8 - 12 during the '18-'19 school year.

IMPORTANT:

1. Each member participating in the bicycle rodeo must furnish their own bicycle and helmet. No bicycle will be shared between participants.

To complete the 4-H Bicycle Project, you must compete in the Bicycle Rodeo and/or 2. exhibit a poster on something you have learned from your bicycle manual.
