

Hello 4-H Beef Members and Families:

4-H Beef Superintendent Jean Ann Knoy has requested that you read the announcements below.

1. What can/can't I use to fit my 4-H Beef animals? Let's start with the products you CAN use to fit for the 4-H Beef Show on Monday July 29<sup>th</sup>. You can use daily hair care products. Those include Kleen Sheen, Flare, pink oil and Final Bloom. Fly spray is permissible as well. Brushes, combs, blowers, are also acceptable.
2. Paint, dye and adhesives are NOT ACCEPTABLE for the 4-H Beef Show. PUMPING of air, fluids or otherwise is NOT ACCEPTABLE in any way.
3. Tack and mulch move-in days begin Wednesday July 24<sup>th</sup>. Names will be on the stalls ahead of time. Please do not change other exhibitors' stall names, as this is rude to your neighbors and does not reflect the values taught in 4-H.
4. The effort to improve the Cattle Barn is moving along! Posts are in place in the tie-out area, and gates will be mounted in the near future. Gates inside the barn will be installed before the fair, and we look forward to the positive improvement this will make in our facility. Families, farms and businesses have shown support of this effort by contributing over \$30,000 to keep 4-H Beef projects viable in the future. A huge thank you goes to these supporters and the committee of 4-H parents who have made this happen.
5. Feed, wash, dry, brush, walk, repeat. See you in a few short weeks!
